The Greyhounds split four games at the rain-shortened Salisbury State University Sea Gull Invitational last weekend. Moravian defeated St. Joseph's College (ME), 14-5, and Lynchburg College (VA), 8-1, while losing to Western Maryland College, 6-3, and Cabrini College, 7-2.

In the win over St. Joseph's, Moravian had 17 hits in the game led by sophomore first baseman **Deb Noble** (**Cranford, NJ/Cranford HS**) with three hits in five at-bats. Noble also had five RBIs in the game while sophomore outfielder **Sarah Leiby** (**Fleetwood/Fleetwood HS**) had three hits in four at-bats with three RBIs, two runs scored and a double. Sophomore outfielder **Summer Miller** (**Mt. Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley HS**) was also three-for-four with two doubles and two runs scored while junior outfielder **Missy Hummel** (**Walnutport/Northampton HS**) was three-for-four with four runs scored. Senior shortstop **Zan Azzolino** (**Lodi, NJ/Immaculate Heart Academy**) also had three hits and scored two runs scored. Senior **Becky Stroup** (**Palmerton/Palmerton HS**) earned the victory on the mound, allowing eight hits, five walks and three strikeouts.

Against Western Maryland, Leiby had three hits in four at-bats again with a double. Noble had a RBI double in the loss as did sophomore catcher **Stacy Matuczinski** (**Bethlehem/Liberty HS**).
