The Greyhounds posted a 3-1 record last week with a doubleheader split with Messiah College in MAC Commonwealth Conference action, losing the first game 5-1 and winning the second contest 9-1 in five innings, and sweeping a MAC Commonwealth Conference twinbill at Elizabethtown College, 7-1 and 5-2, to remain in first place in the MAC Commonwealth Conference.

Against Messiah, the Greyhounds gave away the first game, committing three errors in the top of the first inning leading to four unearned runs and another error in the seventh inning for another unearned run for the Falcons. Senior pitcher Becky Stroup (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS) had five strikeouts in the game. Moravian scored its only run of the contest on a RBI single by sophomore outfielder Sarah Leiby (Fleetwood/Fleetwood HS) that scored junior outfielder Missy Hummel (Walnutport/Northampton HS). In the second contest, the Greyhounds knocked out 12 hits and sophomore pitcher Rachel Mowrey (Hellertown/Saucon Valley HS) tossed a two-hitter for the win. Sophomores catcher Stacy Matuczinski (Bethlehem/Liberty HS), designated player Deb Noble (Cranford, NJ/Cranford HS) and second baseman Laurie Rentschler (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS) each had two hits in the game as did Leiby, who also had a double. Noble drove in four runs in the contest including the last two that ended the game in five innings. Matuczinski and Rentschler each had two RBIs in the contest.

In the doubleheader at Elizabethtown, the Greyhounds won the first game behind Stroup on the mound. Stroup had three strikeouts and allowed four hits and three walks in the game. Sophomore outfielder Summer Miller (Mt. Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley Regional HS) had three hits in the game with a double while Leiby had two hits, including a double and a triple, with two RBIs. Freshman first baseman Kim Gehman (Topton/Brandywine Heights HS) also had two hits in the game with a triple while Noble drove in a pair of runs with two hits and a triple. In the second game, Mowrey limited Elizabethtown to five hits and two unearned runs while walking on and striking out three for her seventh win of the season. Matuczinski had two of the Greyhounds five hits and scored two runs while Gehman and Miller each drove in runs.

The Greyhounds posted a 2-1 mark last week with a pair of wins in MAC Commonwealth Conference action that put Moravian one match from clinching a spot in the MAC Playoffs. Moravian defeated Albright College, 5-2, and Susquehanna University, 4-3, while losing to rival Muhlenberg College, 5-2, in non-conference action.

In the victory over Albright, senior Clay Wagner (Havertown/Haverford HS), junior Clay Smith (Bethlehem/Liberty HS) and freshmen Todd Edwards (Conyngham/Hazleton HS) and Dan Gorman (Saylorsburg/Pleasant Valley HS) each had singles wins. Wagner and Edwards combined for one doubles win while Smith partnered with freshman David Kurvink (Bethlehem/Liberty HS) for a doubles win.

In the match at Muhlenberg, the Greyhounds had only two winners in singles action, Smith and senior **Jason Birli (Quakertown/Quakertown HS)**. Smith also had a singles win at Susquehanna as did Kurvink, Wagner and Gorman. Smith and Kurvink also won in doubles action for the Greyhounds at Susquehanna.

The Lady Greyhounds hosted the Moravian Invitational and had seven first place finishes on the day. Sophomore Sarah Shaneberger (Bethlehem/Southern Lehigh HS) won two events, the hammer throw in 37.28 meters and the shot put at 11.74 meters while sophomore Jennifer Lohn (Media/Penncrest HS) captured the javelin at 35.24 meters. In the running events, sophomore Steph Horne (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS) won the 100-meter high hurdles in 15.9 meters while sophomore Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS) captured the 1,500 meters in a NCAA Division III provisional qualifying time of 4:39.50. Sophomore Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS) won the 10,000 meters in her first race of the season in a school record and NCAA Division III provisional qualifying time of 37:21.44. The Greyhounds also won the 3,200-meter relay with the team of Wolfsberger, junior Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS), sophomore Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy) and sophomore Amanda Samok (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS) in a Breidegam Track record of 9:37.82.

Sophomore Carrie McCaffery (Lebanon/Annville-Cleona HS) placed second in the shot put at 10.26 meters, third in the hammer throw at 31.98 meters and fourth in the javelin at 31.34 meters. Sophomore Melissa Webber (Barnegat, NJ/Monsignor Donovan HS) was third in the discus with a toss of 34.02 meters and fourth in the hammer throw at 20.94 meters. Freshman Ann Corless (Plainsville, CT/Plainsville HS) placed second in the long jump at 4.68 meters while senior Erica Landes (Reading/Muhlenberg HS) was fourth at 4'10". Freshman Brooke Dawson (Emmaus/Emmaus HS) was fifth in the high jump at 4'8".

On the track, freshman **Jen Ketz (Canadensis/Pocono Mountain HS)** was second in the 400-meter intermediate hurdles in 1:6.88 and Horne was third in 1:08.35. Wolfsberger was second in the 800 meters in 2:18.67 and Boyle was third at 2:21.14. Sophomore **Jen Burkholder (Chalfont/Gwynedd Mercy HS)** won her heat of the 800 meters in 2:28.16. Samok captured first in her heat of the 1,500 meters at 5:11.93 while freshman **Gina Lacombe (Andover, CT/Rham HS)** won her heat in 5:28.03. Senior **Maria Grabowski (Churchville/Villa Joseph Marie HS)** placed second in the 10,000 meters at 41:55.95 while junior **Kate Westerman (Milford, CT/Lauralton Hall HS)** was third in 46:06.80. Horne, Burkholder, Ketz and Corless placed third in the 400-meter relay in 53.32 while Corless, Ketz, Burkholder and Lacombe were third in the 1,600-meter relay in 4:18.85.

The Greyhounds hosted the Moravian Invitational last weekend and had seven first place finishes. Junior Anthony Rediger (Sellersville/Pennridge HS) captured first in triple jump at 12.84 meters while senior Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS) won the 110-meter high hurdles in 17.28 seconds. Sophomore Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS) was first in the 200 meters in 22.57 seconds while sophomore Josh Heebner (Lansdale/North Penn HS) won the 800 meters in 1:57.37. Senior Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS) was first in the 15:34.72 while freshman Wes Zimmerman (Boyertown/Boyertown HS) captured the 10,000 meters in 33.20.94. The Greyhounds 1,600-meter relay team won first place in 3:29.23.

In the field events, senior **Josh Tirado (Weatherly/Weatherly HS)** was third in the hammer throw at 33.34 meters and second in the discus with a throw of 33.56 meters. Rediger placed third in the long jump at 6.04 meters while freshman **John Stanko (Lansford/Panther Valley HS)** was fourth at 5.84 meters and senior **Travis Fink (Palmerton/Palmerton Area HS)** was fifth at 5.69 meters. Senior **Kyle Harryn (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** placed fifth in the javelin at 45.59 meters while O'Rourke placed fourth in the high jump at 5'10". Stanko also placed third in the triple jump with a distance of 12.46 meters.

Bush placed fourth in the 100 meters in 11.42 seconds while freshman Chris Colly (Easton/Easton HS) placed first in his heat of the 200 meters in 23.73 seconds. Colly was third in the 400 meters in 52.62 while freshman George Wacker (Honesdale/Honesdale HS) was second in the 800 meters in 1:57.44. Senior Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS) placed third in the 1,500 meters in 4:07.50 while senior Michael Keysock (Bethlehem/Freedom HS) was second in the 10,000 meters at 36:10.53 and freshman Justin Arnold (Basking Ridge, NJ/Ridge HS) was third in the 10,000 with a time of 36:10.96.

The Greyhounds posted a 1-3 mark last week and had two games canceled due to weather. Moravian split a MAC Commonwealth Conference doubleheader with Susquehanna University, winning the first game 12-8 and losing the nightcap 6-5. The Greyhounds lost Middle Atlantic Conference games to Delaware Valley College, 8-3, and Drew University, 4-3. The second game of the twinbill with Drew on Sunday was canceled in the third inning due to rain while the team's game last Monday with NCAA Division I Lehigh University was canceled due to a rescheduled league doubleheader for Lehigh.

In the game versus Delaware Valley, freshman first baseman **Bob Frey** (**Hellertown/Saucon Valley HS**) connected on a solo homerun in the sixth inning to cut the Aggies lead to 6-3. The homer was Frey's sixth of the season, tying the school record set by **Ed Barnett** in 1985. The Greyhounds had already broken the school record for homeruns as a team in a season and Frey's round-tripper was the 18th of the season but the first hit at Gillespie Field. Sophomore third baseman **Bill Quinn** (**Lebanon**, **CT/Lyman Memorial HS**) had a RBI double in the game while junior shortstop **Mike Gill (Lebanon**, **NJ/North Hunterdon HS**) had a RBI single. Junior catcher **Dustin Levy** (**Vineland**, **NJ/Vineland HS**) contributed two of the Greyhounds' seven hits in the game. Sophomore pitcher **Randy Woolley** (**Manahawkin**, **NJ/Southern Regional HS**) suffered the loss for Moravian.

Frey would break the record in the first game at Susquehanna, which was played at Selinsgrove High School due to renovations at Susquehanna. Frey was three for five in the game with two RBIs while senior Jarrett Hughes (Bangor/Bangor Area HS) had three hits, fours runs scored, a double and a RBI. Hughes' third hit in the game was the 124th of his career, breaking the old Moravian record of 123 set by Mike Folcher from 1994 to 1997. Junior outfielder Joe Pochron (Allentown/Salisbury HS) had his fourth homerun of the season among three hits in the game and Pochron also had a double and four RBIs. Freshman third baseman Jeff Meila (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS) added three hits in the game while Quinn had a pair of hits including a double. Senior Matt Seitzinger (Scranton/Scranton Prep) returned to the mound after missing a start with an elbow injury and picked up a win, going six innings with five strikeouts, seven hits and four earned runs. Woolley pitched the final inning of the game and also threw the final 2 2/3 innings of the second game after the Crusaders chased starter David Jelleme (Pequannock, NJ/Pequannock HS) with three homeruns and five runs in 3 1/3 innings. Hughes, Pochron, Quinn and Meila each had two hits in the game. Pochron had two RBIs and a double while Frey and Quinn hit doubles.

In the game against Drew, Hughes, Pochron and Meila each had two hits with Pochron and Hughes having RBIs. Pochron also added a double while Frey drove in a run. Pochron suffered the loss on the mound, giving up four runs, but only one was earned. He also had seven strikeouts. Freshman **Mike Schlamp (Nazareth/Nazareth Area HS)** finished second for the Greyhounds with a round of 81 in his first action of the spring. Senior **Geoff Hood (Willow Grove/Upper Moreland HS)** had a 84 at the Five Ponds Golf Club for Moravian while freshmen **Anthony Gill (Wilkes-Barre/Hanover Area HS)** and **Charles Tice (Manasquan, NJ/Manasquan HS)** had rounds of 85 and 86 respectively for the Greyhounds.
