Women's Soccer – 8-3 (MAC Commonwealth Conference 2-1, MAC 5-1)

Last Week – Defeated *Lebanon Valley, 3-1; Defeated #Allentown, 3-1. #MAC match, *MAC Commonwealth This Week – Fri., Oct. 8th at Gettysburg College, 4:00 p.m.

The women's soccer team won a pair of matches last week to improve its record to 8-3 on the year. The eight victories are equal to the total number of wins during the 1998 season. Last week, Moravian defeated Lebanon Valley College, 3-1, on Wednesday in MAC Commonwealth Conference action then the Lady Greyhounds defeated Allentown College by the same score on Saturday in Middle Atlantic Conference action.

Senior forward Carli Miller (Wyomissing/Wilson West Lawn HS) scored three goals last week and added one assist. She scored the first goal against Lebanon Valley and netted the first two goals in the victory against Allentown. Miller assisted on the other goal in the Allentown match, which was scored by junior midfielder Becky Matijasich (Alpharetta, GA/Wilson West Lawn {PA} HS). Other goal scorers for the Lady Greyhounds last week were freshman forward Morgan Underhill (Chatham, NJ/Chatham HS) and sophomore defender Stevie Ochse (Bethlehem/Saucon Valley HS). Underhill's goal was the first of her career.

Senior midfielder **Jen Polaha** (**Seattle, WA/Wilson West Lawn {PA} HS**) and junior midfielder **Marisa Confuorto** (**Neshanic Station, NJ/Hillsborough HS**) each had two assists last week. Underhill also had an assist. Freshman goalie **Neali Miller** (**Wyomissing/Wilson West Lawn HS**) made her first collegiate start against Lebanon Valley and picked up the win while making three saves. Neali Miller also played the final 30 minutes of match against Allentown with one save. Junior goalie **Becky Roe** (**Worcester, NY/Worcester Central HS**) made one save in 60 minutes against Allentown.

Mack's goal was the first of his career. Sophomore midfielder Evan Weller (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS) had two assists. Sophomore midfielder Paul Melniczek (Philade lphia/Roman Catholic HS) netted the only goal in the loss at Allentown off a pass from sophomore defender Scott Heydt (Boyertown/Boyertown HS).

The football team dropped a 40-14 game to Widener University in MAC Commonwealth Conference action last Saturday. Senior quarterback **Rob Petrosky** (**North Catasauqua/Catasauqua HS**) completed 16 of 29 passes for 153 yards and two touchdowns to lead the Greyhounds offense. Petrosky's touchdown passes were to junior fullback **Frank Starner** (**Nazareth/Nazareth HS**) and freshman wide receiver **Jarod Rhinehart** (**Washington, NJ/Warren Hills Regional HS**). Junior tailback **P.J. Jankowicz** (**Belle Mead, NJ/Hillsborough HS**) gained 26 yards on 11 carries to lead the running attack.

Junior linebacker **Phil Black** (**Easton/Easton HS**) made 11 tackles last week including six solo stops to lead the Greyhound defense. Senior cornerback **Gordy Frack** (**Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS**) had an interception, which he returned 22 yards, four pass break-ups and eight tackles. Junior cornerback **Doug Joseph** (**Allentown/Parkland HS**) returned four kickoffs for 66 yards and two punts for 11 yards. Joseph had six solo tackles in the loss. Senior free safety **Steve DiRenzo** (**Netcong, NJ/Lenape Valley Regional HS**) made a total of nine tackles last Saturday and added two pass break-ups while senior linebacker **Josh Wren** (**Milford, UT/Cyprus HS**) made seven tackles.

The Lady Greyhounds clinched a playoff spot for the fourth straight year and extended their winning streak to 41 consecutive matches with three wins last week. Moravian defeated NCAA Division II Kutztown University of Pennsylvania, 6-0 in a rain shortened match on Tuesday, Elizabethtown College, 7-2 in MAC Commonwealth Conference action on Thursday, and Messiah College, 6-3 on Saturday in MAC Commonwealth Conference action.

Sophomore Corinne Kleinsmith (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS) won all five of her matches last week with a trio victories in singles action and a pair of doubles wins with partner senior Marnie Heller (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS). Heller had one singles win last week while sophomore Lacey Leverberg (East Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS) won her three singles matches. Senior Lyn Ramsey (Perkasie/Pennridge HS) and junior Courtney Rice (Nazareth/Nazareth Area HS) won two doubles matches last week to keep their undefeated record this season. The Moravian men's cross-country team placed 12th of 23 teams behind a fifth place finish by senior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** at the Frostburg State (MD) University Invitational. Pfluger finished the 8,000-meter course, the same course the NCAA Division III Mideast Regional will be run on in November, in a time of 26:8.3, his best time of the season.

Rounding out the top five for the Greyhounds were freshman **George Wacker** (**Honesdale/Honesdale HS**) in 58th place at 28:03.1, junior **Damon Rutherford** (**Reading/Exeter HS**) at 70th with a time of 28:20.0, sophomore **Tim McDade** (**Bechtelsville/Boyertown HS**) in 110th in 29:15.0 and senior **Michael Keysock** (**Bethlehem/Freedom HS**) in 141st with a time of 20:08.6. There were 217 runners in the field.

Senior outside hitter **Amy Sandt** (**Allentown/William Allen HS**) had 43 kills, 63 digs and 12 service aces. Sandt had seven service aces against Albright. Moravian had 19 service aces in he match against the Lions. Senior setter **Kaitie Kramer** (**Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS**) had 138 assists and six service aces last week. The Moravian women's cross-country team, which has been ranked eighth in the nation the last two weeks in the NCAA Division III Top 25 poll, placed second of 23 teams in the Frostburg State (MD) Invitational last Saturday. Four Lady Greyhounds placed in the top 15 at the race, which was held on the same course that will be used for the NCAA Division III Mideast Regional in November.

Sophomore Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS) placed third with a time of 18:58.8 over the 5,000-meter course. Sophomore Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS) was seventh in 19:23.0 and junior Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS) in eighth with a time of 19:23.7. Sophomore Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS) also placed in the top 15 at 14th in 19:38.6. Moravian had four other runners in the field of 201. Senior Maria Grabowski (Churchville/Villa Joseph Marie) was 42nd in 20:35.6 while junior Kate Westermann (Milford, CT/Lauralton Hall) was 45th in 20:36.6. Sophomore Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy) placed 61st with a time of 20:56.7 while freshman Jennifer Wagner (Riegelsville/Wilson HS) was 79th in 21:16.8.
