**Women's Cross Country 0-0 (MAC Commonwealth Conference 0-0, MAC 0-0)**

*Last Week – 1<sup>st</sup> of 28 at Dickinson Invitational, Carlisle, PA*

**This Week – Sun., Oct. 17<sup>th</sup> at Allentown College Invitational, Center Valley, PA**

The Moravian women's cross-country team captured its second win of the season with a team score of 96 at the Dickinson College Invitational last Saturday. The Lady Greyhounds, ranked ninth in the nation in last week's NCAA Division III National Poll, led the 28 team field behind three top ten finishes. Sophomore **Emily Shertzer (Hummelstown/Lower Dauphin HS)** was sixth overall out of 237 runners with a time of 19:14.00 over the 5,000-meter course. Junior **Hannah Wood (Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS)** was one spot behind Shertzer in 19:14.49. Sophomore **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** was ninth in the race with a time of 19:21.39.

Moravian had five other runners competed at the Dickinson Invitational with sophomore **Kim Jaick (Coopersburg/Southern Lehigh HS)** leading the quintet with a 25<sup>th</sup> place finish in 19:56.57. Sophomore **Erin Boyle (Philadelphia/Nazareth Academy)** finished 50<sup>th</sup> in 20:32.73 while junior **Kate Westermann (Milford, CT/Lauralton Hall HS)** was 53<sup>rd</sup> in 20:35.14. Senior **Maria Grabowski (Churchville/Villa Joseph Maria HS)** placed 79<sup>th</sup> with a time of 20:57.76 while freshman **Jen Wagner (Riegelsville/Wilson HS)** rounded out the Lady Greyhounds runners in 97<sup>th</sup> place at 21:12.58.

The Moravian men's cross-country team placed 11<sup>th</sup> of 28 teams at the Dickinson College Invitational behind a 14<sup>th</sup> place finish by senior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)**. Pfluger finished the 8,000-meter course in a time of 26:49.98.

Moravian had five other runners among the 215 in the field. Junior **Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS)** placed 74<sup>th</sup> in 28:23.60 while sophomore **Tim McDade (Bechtelsville/Boyertown HS)** was 85<sup>th</sup> with a time of 28:41.89. Freshman **George Wacker (Honesdale/Honesdale HS)** finished 98<sup>th</sup> in 28:56.14. Sophomore **Chris DeWalt (Easton/Easton HS)** was 119<sup>th</sup> in 29:20.38 while senior **Michael Keysock (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** finished 137<sup>th</sup> with a time of 30:12.57.

**Football – 0-5 (MAC Commonwealth Conference 0-3, MAC 0-5)**

The football team dropped a tough 21-19 contest to King's College in Middle Atlantic Conference action last Saturday. Moravian trailed 21-6 with five minutes left in the game before scoring two late touchdowns. However, time ran out on the Greyhounds as the team lost its seventh straight game dating back to 1998.

Trailing 14-0 in the third quarter, senior quarterback **Rob Petrosky (North Catasauqua/Catasauqua HS)** connected with freshman wide receiver **Jarod Rhinehart (Washington, NJ/Warren Hills Regional HS)** from 15 yards out. Junior **Kevin Smith (Collegeville/Methacton HS)** missed the extra-point. After King's scored again to make the score 21-6, Petrosky connected with Rhinehart again from ten yards out for a second touchdown. Petrosky's two-point conversion attempt to senior tight end **Kevin McHale (Dunmore/Dunmore HS)** was too high. Rhinehart caught five passes for 81 yards and the two touchdowns on the afternoon.

Petrosky, who hit senior wide receiver **Dan Oliynik (Dover, NJ/Morris Knolls HS)** for a 26 yard touchdown pass with 17 seconds left in the game, completed 11 of 25 passes for 174 yards and three touchdowns with just one interception. Sophomore **Jim McIntyre (Hackettstown/Hackettstown HS)** made the extra-point after the Oliynik touchdown to reach the final score of 21-19.

Moravian gained just 92 yards on the ground against King's led by 63 from junior tailback **P.J. Jankowicz (Belle Mead, NJ/Hillsborough HS)**. On the defensive side of the ball, freshman linebacker **John Cupples (Allentown/Allentown Central Catholic HS)**, who made his first career start against King's, led the Greyhounds with 18 tackles, two shy of the school record, one tackle for loss and one pass break-up. Cupples' 12 solo tackles was one shy of the single game record at Moravian. Senior strong safety **Jason Goldan (Neshanic, NJ/ Hillsborough HS)** added 17 tackles and an interception in the game while junior linebacker **Phil Black (Easton/Easton HS)** had 15 tackles including two for loss.

The Lady Greyhounds won three matches last week to extend their winning streak to 44 consecutive matches. Moravian also finished its second straight MAC Commonwealth Conference season with an undefeated record of 7-0 after a 6-3 victory over Lebanon Valley College on Saturday.

Sophomores **Corinne Kleinsmith (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS)**, **Katie Copf (Allentown/Salisbury HS)** and **Lacey Leverberg (East Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** each had three singles wins last week. Freshman **Jen Genevese (Whitehall/Whitehall HS)** had a pair of singles victories while junior **Autumn Zander (Riegelsville/Bethlehem Catholic HS)**, senior **Marnie Heller (Shillington/Governor Mifflin HS)** and freshman **Missy Graeff (Reading/Schuylkill Valley HS)** each had one singles win.

In doubles action, senior **Lyn Ramsey (Perkasie/Pennridge HS)** and junior **Courtney Rice (Nazareth/Nazareth Academy HS)** combined for a pair of wins, however, the duo lost its first match of the season at Muhlenberg College, 9-8 (7-4). Leverberg and Genevese also combined for two victories last week.

The women's volleyball team, ranked fifth in the NCAA Division III Mid-Atlantic Regional Poll last week, captured a 15-10, 9-15, 15-6, 15-12 victory over Richard Stockton College of New Jersey in its only action last week. Richard Stockton was ranked eighth in the Mid-Atlantic Region.

Senior outside hitter **Amy Sandt (Allentown/William Allen HS)** led Moravian with 25 kills and 32 digs in the match while senior setter **Kaitie Kramer (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** had 56 assists, 17 digs and eight kills. Junior middle hitter **Becky Falk (Allentown/Dieruff HS)** had 15 kills while classmate and middle hitter **Sara Young (Tunkhannock/Tunkhannock HS)** had nine kills and three blocks.

Sophomore opposite hitter **Sara Walkiewicz (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** added 18 digs, six blocks and six kills while junior defensive specialist **Natalie Balaziuk (Bethlehem/Bethlehem Catholic HS)** had 20 digs and four service aces. Junior defensive specialist **Emily Shonk (Ligonier/Ligonier HS)** added 15 digs and three aces. Sophomore outside hitter **Krystol Kessack (Bethlehem/Liberty HS)** contributed nine kills in the match.

Freshman **Mary Peterson (Clemmons, NC/Salem Academy)** finished the game in goal for the Lady Greyhounds. Fillian and Peterson each played a full half in a 2-0 loss to Elizabethtown College last week.
