Moravian suffered a pair of losses last week in its first two MAC Commonwealth Conference games of the 1999-2000 season. The Lady Greyhounds fell to Widener University, 85-66, last Tuesday and lost at home to Juniata College, 59-50 on Saturday.

In the loss to Widener, senior forward LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS) led Moravian with 18 points and seven rebounds. Senior guard Jen Polaha (Seattle, WA/Holy Name {PA} HS) contributed 12 points while freshman forward Kelly McLean (Allentown/Salisbury HS) had eight points and seven rebounds. Freshman guard Tara Wozniak (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS) also scored eight points in the loss.

Sophomore forward Mary Morgans (Center Valley/Allentown Central Catholic HS) paced the Lady Greyhounds in the loss to Juniata with 13 points and eight rebounds. She also had a career high four steals in the game. McLean added ten points, five rebounds and two blocked shots against the Eagles while Johnson had nine points and six rebounds.

The 'Hounds split their first two MAC Commonwealth Conference games of the 1999-2000 season, losing on the road to Widener University, 60-47, and winning at home against Juniata College, 69-48. The win against Juniata was the first home game of the season for Moravian and snapped a three-game losing streak.

In the contest at Widener, senior guard **Rich Whalen (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** and junior guard/forward **David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS)** each scored 11 points to lead Moravian. Senior center **Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS)** had a team high 12 rebounds while freshman forward **Ken Greb (Mt. Holly, NJ/Rancocas valley HS)** added eight points and eight rebounds.

Sophomore guard **Doug Spadt (Emmaus/Emmaus HS)** led the 'Hounds to the win over Juniata with 12 points and three steals. O'Rourke had 11 points and six rebounds before fouling out of the contest. Whalen and Jordan each had nine points and four rebounds in the game and Whalen added five steals. Greb had six rebounds to go along with four points while junior forward **Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS)** had seven points off the bench. Senior guard **Justin Potts (Sparta, NJ/Sparta HS)** grabbed five rebounds in each game last week as a reserve.
