### Men's Basketball – 4-4 (MAC Commonwealth Conference 1-2, MAC 2-3)

The 'Hounds posted a 2-1 record last week to finish out the 1999 portion of their schedule with a 4-4 slate. Moravian defeated the University of Scranton, 70-68, in a Middle Atlantic Conference game, before falling to Susquehanna University, 71-52, in a MAC Commonwealth Conference contest. The 'Hounds closed out the week with a 90-59 win over rival Muhlenberg College.

In the victory against Scranton, in which Moravian let a 21-point lead slip away before winning the contest, senior center Jim O'Rourke (Park Ridge, NJ/Park Ridge HS) tied his career high with 14 points and added eight rebounds in the game to lead Moravian. O'Rourke was one of five Moravian players to score in double figures in the game and all six Greyhounds that scored had at least nine points. Senior guard Rich Whalen (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS) had 13 points and had career highs with ten assists and seven rebounds while sophomore guard Doug Spadt (Emmaus/Emmaus HS) also scored 13 points. Junior guard/forward David Jordan (Point Pleasant, NJ/Point Pleasant HS), who made two free throws with eight seconds left added 11 points while freshman forward Ken Greb (Mt. Holly, NJ/Rancocas Valley HS) added ten points and seven rebounds. Junior forward Chris Hayn (Whitehall/Whitehall HS) had nine points and seven boards in the game. In the loss to Susquehanna, O'Rourke again led the Greyhounds in scoring and he tied his career high for the second straight game with 14 points. Greb was the only other Moravian player to score in double digits in the game with 12 points. Greb also led Moravian on the boards with five rebounds. Jordan tallied eight points in the loss while Spadt had seven points.

Spadt and O'Rourke each set new career highs in points in the impressive victory over Muhlenberg last Saturday to end the first part of the season. Spadt netted 17 points and connected on seven of nine field goal attempts. The only two shots Spadt missed were three-pointers. As a team in the game, the Greyhounds posted a perfect night from the foul line with 15 made free throws in 15 attempts. O'Rourke posted 16 points for the Greyhounds and had a team high five rebounds. All five starters scored in double figures for Moravian while the six reserves that scored all had four points in the game. Whalen netted 12 points and added five assists while Jordan had 11 points. Hayn tied O'Rourke with five rebounds and also scored ten points. Greb had four points in the game as did sophomore guard Bruce DeLauder (Reading/Reading Central Catholic HS), freshman guard Kevin Hall (Mountain Top/Pocono Mountain HS), senior guard Pete Bilinsky (Pennsauken, NJ/Camden Catholic HS), senior guard Justin Potts (Sparta, NJ/Sparta HS) and sophomore forward Mike Frew (Glen Ridge, NJ/Glen Ridge HS).

Sophomore **Heidi Wolfsberger (Moosic/Riverside HS)** placed first in the mile race with a time of 5:22.7 to lead the Lady Greyhounds at the Lafayette Invitational. There were no team scores kept at the invitational. Sophomore **Steph Horne (Sinking Spring/Wilson West Lawn HS)** did set a school record for Moravian in the 60-yard high hurdles with a time of 8.8 seconds. Horne placed seventh in the race while freshman **Jennifer Ketz** (**Canadensis/Pocono Mountain HS)** was 13th in her first collegiate race with a time of 9.7 seconds. In addition to Wolfsberger, the Lady Greyhounds had two other runners in the mile race with junior **Hannah Wood** (**Palm/Upper Perkiomen HS)** placing second in 5:33.3 and senior **Maria Grabowski** (**Churchville/Villa Joseph Maria HS)** finishing third with a time of 5:47.0.

Freshman **Ann Corless (Plainville, CT/Plainville HS)** placed eighth in the 440-yard dash in a time of 1:05.2. Freshman **Jennifer Wagner (Riegelsville/Wilson HS)** placed ninth in 1:05.6 while Ketz was 12<sup>th</sup> in the race in 1:06.8. Horne finished eighth in the 220-yard dash in 28.9 seconds while Ketz was 10<sup>th</sup> in 29.3 and Corless was 11<sup>th</sup> in 29.4 seconds. Junior **Brooke Dancho (Bethlehem/Freedom HS)** placed third in the long jump with a leap of 5.13 meters.

### Women's Basketball - 1-6 (MAC Commonwealth Conference 0-3, MAC 0-4)

Moravian suffered a pair of losses last week to head into the Christmas holiday with a 1-6 record. The Lady Greyhounds were ahead at halftime of both games last week but ended up losing to Susquehanna University, 78-68, in MAC Commonwealth Conference action and to Marymount University (VA), 75-62, in non-conference action.

In the loss to Susquehanna, Moravian had four players in double figures led by senior forward LaJona Johnson (Easton/Easton HS), who had 16 points and a team high nine rebounds. Freshman forward Kelly McLean (Allentown/Salisbury HS) added 15 points and six rebounds while freshman guard Tara Wozniak (Roseland, NJ/West Essex Regional HS) had a double-double with 13 points and a career high 12 rebounds. Wozniak added three blocked shots while senior guard Jen Polaha (Seattle, WA/Holy Name {PA} HS) had 12 points and a career best nine assists. Sophomore forward Mary Morgans (Center Valley/Allentown Central Catholic HS) had nine rebounds and four points in the contest while junior forward Becky Roe (Worcester, NY/Worcester Central HS) had five rebounds and four points.

In the game against Marymount, McLean tied her career highs for points and rebounds with the second double-double of her career. McLean netted 19 points and added 12 rebounds in the game. Morgans scored a career high 14 points in the loss and added six rebounds while freshman guard **Jennifer Tannous (Bethlehem/Liberty HS)** had ten points and four rebounds. Johnson netted nine points in the game, all of them in the first half of the contest, while Polaha led Moravian with seven assists. Junior guard **Jill Kenny (East Brunswick, NJ/East Brunswick HS)** had five assists in the game and Roe added five rebounds.

Senior **Tim Pfluger (Slatington/Northern Lehigh HS)** set the Moravian College record and finished first in the two-mile race to pace the Greyhounds at the Lafayette Invitational. Pfluger finished the race in 9:39.8, shaving over three seconds off the previous school record. Junior **Damon Rutherford (Reading/Exeter HS)** placed second in the two-mile race in 9:48.2. Sophomore **Kevin Bush (Stroudsburg/Stroudsburg HS)** placed third in the finals of the 60-yard dash in 6.4 seconds while sophomore **Chris Colley (Easton/Easton HS)** was 15<sup>th</sup> in the 60-yard dash.

Freshman George Wacker (Honesdale/Honesdale HS) placed eighth in the 880-yard run in 2:03.0 while teammate and sophomore Tim McDade (Becthelsville/Boyertown HS) was 12<sup>th</sup> in the race with a time of 2:09.2. Junior Lyle Lentz (Glenolden/Streth Haven HS) placed fourth in the 300-yard dash in 33.9 seconds while Colley was 13<sup>th</sup> in 36.3 seconds. Junior Anthony Rediger (Sellersville/Pennridge HS) led four Moravian finishers in the long jump, placing eighth with a leap of 6.15 meters. Junior Napo Ghanda (Whitehall/Freedom HS) was 11<sup>th</sup> at 5.59 meters while freshman John Stanko (Lansford/Panther Valley HS) was 13<sup>th</sup> at 5.41 meters and senior Travis Fink (Palmerton/Palmerton HS) was 14<sup>th</sup> at 5.22 meters.
